

Ambassador Carlo Trezza is a member of the Advisory Board of the UN Secretary General for Disarmament Matters, a UN body which he chaired in 2010. On October 26 2012 he was appointed as Chairman Designate of the Missile Technology Control Regime (MTCR). He formerly served as Italy's Ambassador to the Republic of Korea, Ambassador for Disarmament and Non-proliferation in Geneva and Permanent Representative of Italy to the Conference on Disarmament. Ambassador Trezza joined the Italian Foreign Service in 1970 and served in Zambia, Israel, Germany and Spain. He also held the post as Head of the Press and Information Section of the Embassy of Italy in Washington, DC and as the Head of the European Security and Disarmament Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Rome.
