## The German Bundeswehr & Drones: A Technology Laggard?

- **Z** Small tactical drones have been used for some decades
- 2009: leasing of 3 Israeli "Heron I" (MALE) for Afghanistan via Rheinmetall
- Before: interest in US-Reaper (unarmed)
- ✓ Heron I considered an "interim solution"
  → no European fieldable drone
  → off-the-shelf solution







# The German Bundeswehr & Drones: A Technology Laggard?

- Leasing contract renewed in October 2012
- **Z** Since 2012: first "Euro Hawk" (HALE) tests
- **Up to now: no armed drones**
- **//** Heron:
  - can be armed in principle ...
  - ... but German "pilots" received no respective training (according to parliamentary question)







## The Debate about Procurement of UCAVs

- Until Summer 2012: no official position whatsoever regarding German UCAVs
- Within the Bundeswehr: great interest amongst soldiers but no ministerial statement
- **TV** report about potential procurement  $\rightarrow$  MoD spokesperson promises "public debate"  $\rightarrow$  press picks up on the issue  $\rightarrow$
- Defence Minister de Maizière: Bundeswehr should procure UCAVs

## The Debate about Procurement of UCAVs

- **De Maiziére: weapons are "ethically neutral"**
- **Most recent proponent: chief of the Luftwaffe, Gen. Müller**
- Arguments: force protection & capability of world-wide intervention
- **Müller: Reaper weapon of choice**
- **Not much public criticism**







### The Debate about the US Use of Drones

- Debate about extrajudicial killings: featured by some major magazines, especially "Der Spiegel"
- Focus on civilian casualties, but mixed reception
- Totally separated debate: German government receives leap of faith not to break IHL/International Law
- de Maiziére: "displeased" with CIA attacks but no "official" position









- **Questions: when and what systems rather than whether at all**
- Perception in Germany: German government will use UCAVs with restraint
- **CIA** attacks: American problem rather than a "drone problem"
